Engage in Development

- Co-sponsoring developments
- Key development opportunities during initial migration as "cost of entry"
- Reach out to vendors for development (EBSCO, 3M)
- Cross ILS OS developments (fulfILLment)

- Fast to Fail, taking responsibility for failure, risk-taking






